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## LANGUAGE ACCESS CARD

Non-English speaking persons have a right under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act to free interpretation assistance in their language. The "I Speak" card will help service providers identify a person's language before calling an interpreter for assistance. Remove the card above and use it to request language assistance when accessing services. This card is not required for you to receive services.
